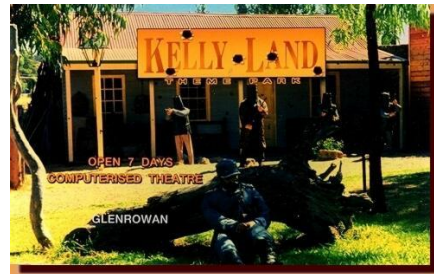

Day 1: Homeports – Glenrowan – Cobram - Barooga (D.)

Welcome aboard your luxury, Christians Bus Company coach as we depart your home town and travel through the scenic Victorian countryside to Glenrowan. This is where in 1880 Ned Kelly and his gang were defeated by police. We visit Kelly Land, through the brilliance of animation and computerized robots, you will be transferred back in time, over 100 years, to witness the events that led up to the capture of the Kelly Gang. Lunch can be purchased at the Billy Tearooms or the local bakery. This afternoon we continue to Barooga and our motel where we are greeted by our hosts and shown to our rooms. Tonight the courtesy bus will transfer us to the Barooga Sports Club for dinner and for those inclined there will be time for a flutter on the pokies before returning to our motel.

Day 2: Koonang Park Alpacas - Cactus Country – Murray River Cruise (B.D.)

Our first stop for today is at Koonang Park Alpacas. Noelene will introduce you to the wonderful world of Alpacas! Be charmed by these cute animals with their big eyes and gentle nature, you may even see a cria (baby alpaca) or two!! Enjoy morning tea and you might like to purchase something from the On Farm Shop. We then visit Cactus Country where once you are out amongst the plants you really do feel like you're in another country. There are approximately 4,000 different species from North America and Mexico, South America and Africa. There will be time to purchase lunch followed by an afternoon enjoying the picturesque Murray River whilst cruising onboard the magnificent Cobba Paddle Boat. Dinner tonight will be at the Barooga Hotel.

Day 3: Corowa – Byramine Homestead – Antique Clock Museum (B.D.)

This morning we follow the Murray River to the small town of Corowa, the birth place of Australian Federation. Following a town tour step back in time and discover Corowa's history and its role in the birth of Federation Australia at the Corowa Federation Museum. Enjoy lunch (BYO) in one of the many cafes. On arrival in Yarrawonga a tour will be provided at Byramine Homestead, hear the amazing story of Elizabeth Hume and how she built the oldest house in country Victoria in 1842, and why it still stands today. Wander around the garden to see the magnificent Elms, the oldest in Victoria. Next we visit the Antique Clock Museum housing over 400 magnificent antique and novelty clocks, all in working order. This is a lifetime collection, and all shapes and sizes have been lovingly restored to tick, chime, dong and cuckoo. There will be time to have a look around Yarrawonga before we make our way back to Barooga and the Sports Club for dinner.

Day 4: Nagambie – Home (B.)

After breakfast we depart Barooga and begin our travel home. Comfort stops will be made along the way including time in Nagambie to purchase our lunch. This afternoon we continue homeward concluding in your homeports after a wonderful time away with friends.
